### WHAT IS THE GRESB INFRASTRUCTURE ASSESSMENT?

The Infrastructure Assessment aims to provide a globally consistent system for rating the sustainability indicators of potential infrastructure investments, both individually and relative to similar assets.

Given the increasing importance of infrastructure in a diversified investment portfolio, investors looking to determine the ESG performance of their assets can become GRESB members to benchmark the infrastructure assets in which they have invested.

WSP is excited to be involved in developing the assessment criteria for the upcoming survey as part of the GRESB Infrastructure Advisory Board. These criteria will cover a variety of sustainability topics, including:

- Policy & Disclosure
- Climate Change Risk & Resiliency

- Land Use and Biodiversity
- > Stakeholder Engagement

## WHAT IS THERE TO GAIN FROM COMPLETING THE SURVEY?

Using GRESB Infrastructure as a tool, participants gain a deeper understanding of the strengths and weaknesses of their assets, and how their investments compare to peers and others outside their peer group. All participants in the GRESB Infrastructure Assessment will have the opportunity to consult their Benchmark Report, which will provide an indepth analysis of their results and score.

All investors will be given access to individual assessments regarding the sustainability indicators of their investments. Using GRESB's Portfolio Analysis Tool, they will also be able to compare the scores obtained by their various assets.
