



### **O1 CFB WILLOW PARK**NOVA SCOTIA, CANADA

WSP was responsible for implementing a contaminated materials management plan at a Canadian Forces Base in Willow Park. Services provided included: site inspection and monitoring of contaminated soil and ground water during construction, supervision of contaminated soil disposal, review of risk management protocols, emergency spill response and acid slate management.

#### **02 BOMBARDIER'S 8 OIL DEPOT** OUEBEC. CANADA

WSP responded to a kerosene spill at the Bombardier No. 8 oil depot. Our team provided services which included pumping and disposal of spilled product to an authorized site, excavation and contaminated soil management and excavation sampling. Water samples were taken to test the downstream hydraulic system from an observation well.

# **03** MINISTRY OF TRANSPORTATION OF QUEBEC, TURCOT PROJECT PHASE 1 QUEBEC, CANADA

WSP has been tasked with the challenge of implementing a remediation project into a construction schedule for the colossal Turcot Interchange project. For the next five years, WSP will act as the lead environmental consultant and provide remedial design techniques for this monumental undertaking.

The facility in question was remediated into a sustainable municipal park coming under budget by \$5M.
